## SPARKLING WINE & CHAMPAGNE

1. PROSECCO SPUMANTE, LAMBERTI Veneto, Italy	£26.00 (175ml) £7.00
Pale straw in colour with fine and persistent bubbles. On the nose it is clean with light green apple aromas. On the palate it has an appealing flavour of green apple and lemon with natural fruitiness and a pleasant aromatic aftertaste.	
2. PROSECCO ROSÉ SPUMANTE, LAMBERTI Veneto, Italy	£29.00
A fruity wine redolent with cranberry and strawberry flavours. Soft playful bubbles and a ripe juicy finish.	
3. CHAMBELLE & CO BRUT, MÉTHODE TRADITIONELLE Loire, France	£40.00
Made in the traditional method with twelve months spent on the lees. The nose reveals toasty notes and a mineral freshness, following with a fresh palate with apple and smoky notes.	
4. CHAMPAGNE BARON ALBERT 'L'UNIVERSELLE' BRUT Champagne, France 	£55.00
A family owned champagne house ran by three sisters who each run a separate strand of the business. This cuvee contains a large percentage of Pinot Meunier giving an approachable wine with strawberry leaf and citrus aromas.	
5. JOSEPH PERRIER 'CUVÉE ROYALE' BRUT Champagne, France 	£70.00
A remarkable and noble Champagne house still under family ownership. Fresh fruity aromas such as pear and red apple lead to richer fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit. The wine is aged for a minimum of 3 years in their cellars giving complexity and sophistication.	

## ROSÉ WINE

6. GRENACHE SYRAH ROSÉ 'LES TERRASSES', VIGNERONS ARDÉCHOIS Ardèche, France	£23.00 (125ml) £4.50 (175ml) £5.70 (250ml) £7.70
Made in a light Provençal style, pale in colour and crisp and mineral in character. Light red berries of cranberry and redcurrant and a crisp, refreshing finish.	
7. ZINFANDEL BLUSH, REALZIN Salento, Italy	£25.00 (125ml) £4.90 (175ml) £6.00 (250ml) £8.40
A beautiful rosé wine with an elegant pink colour, fresh fruit aroma with notes of strawberry, round, soft and delicate fruit taste and a fresh and pleasant aftertaste.	
8. PROVENCE ROSÉ, CHÂTEAU ROUTAS Provence, France	£30.00
A vibrant, dry rose, with a nose of fresh strawberries and anise. A Decanter International Trophy winner for best Rose.	

## WHITE WINE

### LIGHT & CRISP

9. CHENIN BLANC SAUVIGNON BLANC, HIGHVELD Western Cape, S Africa 	£20.00 (125ml) £4.00 (175ml) £4.80 (250ml) £6.70
The nose leads with the Sauvignon aromatics of lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple notes from the Chenin follow on the palate.	
10. CATARATTO PINOT GRIGIO, DEA DEL MARE Sicily, Italy 	£23.00 (125ml) £4.50 (175ml) £5.70 (250ml) £7.70
Lovely easy drinking wine made from Pinot Grigio blended with the local Cataratto grape. Green apple and tropical fruit flavours.	
11. PIQUEPOUL, HENRI DE RICHEMER Côtes de Thau, France	£27.00 (125ml) £5.20 (175ml) £6.70 (250ml) £9.00
Crisp and fresh white from Southern France packed full of zingy citrus flavour.	
12. SAUVIGNON BLANC, SANTA LUZ Valle Central, Chile	£23.00 (125ml) £4.50 (175ml) £5.70 (250ml) £7.70
A zingy Sauvignon with signature lime and fresh cut grass flavours. A crisp clean finish rounds the wine off beautifully.	
13. RIOJA BLANCO, VALDEPALACIOS Rioja, Spain 	£26.00
An intense and fruity aroma denotes the youthful exuberance of this Viura. The light and balanced palate is very tasty with greengage and pear fruits.	
14. RIESLING FEINHERB 'ESSENCE', RAIMUND PRÜM Mosel, Germany 	£33.00
Showcasing the impeccable balance only German Riesling can achieve. Sweet fruit flavours of pineapple and apricot are partnered by a racy acidity and mineral character.	
15. VERMENTINO, MARCO ZANATTA Sardina, Italy	£33.00
A lovely example of the grape with good body and texture. Peach, lemon pith and apricot are all present, as well as a salty mineral tang. Blackcurrant leaf and lemon curd build on the long finish.	
<b>ZESTY &amp; REFRESHING</b>	
16. ALVARINHO 'OCEANUS', FIUZA Tejo, Portugal	£29.00 (125ml) £5.80 (175ml) £7.00 (250ml) £9.70
On the nose there are tropical and citrus fruit aromas and some mineral notes that lead into a fresh and crispy palate with well balanced acidity..	
17. CHARDONNAY, DOMAINE DU CLÉRAY Loire, France 	£32.00
A dead ringer for Chablis, this wine comes from a small property in the cool Loire valley. Oyster shell and crisp green apple, a complex and refreshing wine.	
18. SAUVIGNON BLANC, SEVEN DEGREES Marlborough, New Zealand	£32.00 (125ml) £6.20 (175ml) £7.70 (250ml) £10.70
A crisp, zesty and refreshing Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with notes of citrus fruit, lime, lemongrass and passionfruit.	
19. COTEAUX DU GIENNOIS BLANC, DOMAINE BERTHIER Loire, France	£40.00
A marvellous example of Loire Sauvignon every bit as complex as a Pouilly Fumé. Cool mint, citrus and flinty notes make an elegant and fresh wine.	
20. GRÜNER VELTLINER, NIEDERÖTRREICH Niederosterreich, Austria 	£32.00
Displays slightly spicy aromas of citrus, green apples and pepper. Good body with a harmonious spiciness and pronounced fruitiness on the palate then a delicate spicy finish offering pure drinking pleasure.	
21. VIOGNIER 'GEN' ORGANIC, YALUMBA Riverland, Australia	£33.00
Peach flavours dominate this lush white, which features honeydew melon and coconut notes, with hints of cumin on the textured finish.	
22. SAUVIGNON BLANC, NAUTILUS Marlborough, New Zealand 	£50.00
This Nautilus Sauvignon Blanc is a cut above its peers. It displays intense aromas of blackcurrant bud, passion fruit and hints of mint. The palate introduces a delightful lime based mouth-watering intensity and finishes with a crystal clean sensation.	

## RED WINE

### SOFT & SMOOTH

23. SHIRAZ PINOTAGE, HIGHVELD Western Cape, S Africa 	£20.00 (125ml) £4.00 (175ml) £4.80 (250ml) £6.70
Generous black fruit with spicy aromas, followed by rich, smooth and ripe fruit flavours.	
24. MERLOT 'ALBA', SANTA LUZ Valle Central, Chile 	£23.00 (125ml) £4.50 (175ml) £5.70 (250ml) £7.70
Easy drinking, soft and fruity wine with delicious plum and chocolate flavours.	
25. RIOJA CRIANZA, VALDEPALACIOS Rioja, Spain 	£27.00 (125ml) £5.20 (175ml) £6.70 (250ml) £9.00
The wine occupies a sweet spot where oak and fruit mix together and complement each other perfectly. Complex and intense aromas with cocoa and mulberry notes.	
26. PINOT NOIR 'LES BUIS D'APS', VIGNERONS ARDÉCHOIS Ardèche, France	£30.00 (125ml) £6.00 (175ml) £7.50 (250ml) £10.00
An outstanding Pinot Noir that could compete with many red Burgundies! Ripe cherry, blueberry, toast and spice lead the nose, leading to a structured palate combining fruit, spice and subtle notes of sous bois and oak. A long finish that is fresh and stony with an echo of the bright fruit. Outstanding value wine.	
27. NERO D'AVOLA, BOCCANTINO Sicily, Italy	£25.00
Intense ruby red colour with purple hints. Aromas of violet, spices, and red fruit. Full-bodied but smooth with a velvety and spicy finish on the palate.	
<b>RICH &amp; POWERFUL</b>	
28. PRIMITIVO 'PASSITIVO' (APPASSIMENTO), PAOLO LEO Puglia, Italy	£32.00
This wine borrows the famous technique from Amarone of drying the grapes prior to fermentation. This gives a full bodied, rich, and powerful wine. The nose is complex with cherries, raspberries, and chocolate. The palate is dominated by dried fruit flavours and spice, although powerful it is skilfully kept well balanced.	
29. MALBEC, CAVA NEGRA, BODEGA BARBERIS Mendoza, Argentina 	£28.00 (125ml) £5.70 (175ml) £6.70 (250ml) £9.00
A rugged style that offers cherry and blackberry flavours backed by subtle tannins and structure. A good balance between fruit and spice gives wine that will not disappointment	
30. CABERNET SAUVIGNON MERLOT 'PREMIUM', VERGELEGEN Somerset West, S Africa	£33.00
This wine shows how brilliantly South Africa does with Bordeaux blends. On the nose striking cassis underlined with cedar and a fresh ripe fruit character. On the palate the freshness carries through with a sprightly lingering finish.	
31. HEILAN COO, SHIRAZ MATARO Victoria, Australia	£29.00 (125ml) £5.80 (175ml) £7.00 (250ml) £9.70
Celebrating the iconic Highland cow which admired Australia as here for their gentle nature and high-quality beef. A well-bred wine dripping with plum and chocolate flavours. The Mataro adds a depth and subtle spice notes.	
32. BARBERA '150+1' CASALI DEL BARONE Piedmont, Italy	£32.00
This is an intense ruby red wine, with floral hints combined with slightly matured red fruit nuances. In the mouth, it is full-bodied and round, with a soft aftertaste of dark chocolate and spices.	
<b>COMPLEX &amp; INTRIGUING</b>	
33. CHIANTI RISERVA DOCG, 'ORO DEI SANTI' Tuscany, Italy	£34.00
A fruity aroma with notes of dried cherry, violet, plum, blackthorn and black pepper. The taste is bright, even, with black cherry, plum and oak notes.	
34. CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE 'ROULEPIERRE', AMADIEU Rhône, France 	£35.00
Manual harvests and traditional wine making methods give this wine good concentration and intense fruit aromas of blackberry and plum. Medium-bodied on the palate, a hint of liquorice enhances the pleasantly satisfying finish of this classic Rhône wine.	
35. RIOJA RESERVA, LEZA GARCIA Rioja, Spain	£38.00
The aging for 24 months in barrels and at least a further 12 in the bottle gives this wine superb complexity and soft maturity. It is complex, rich and elegant with aromas of cherry and mocha.	
36. BOURGOGNE ROUGE 'CUVÉE ORIGINE', DOMAINE DU BEAUREGARD Burgundy, France	£45.00
Showing a great complexity of black cherry, currants and pencil shavings. Ample and structured in the mouth with all the charm of Burgundy you might expect.
